



Water Exploitation Index plus (WEI+) at the river basin scale

This dataset presents the Water Exploitation Index plus (WEI+) for European river basin districts

It aims to illustrate pressure on renewable water resources of a defined territory (river basin, sub-basin etc.) in a given period (e.g. seasonal, annual) as a consequence of water use for human activities. Values above 20 % indicate that water resources are under stress, and above 40 % indicate severe stress and a clearly unsustainable use of freshwater resources.


