The values close to 1 mean high presence of habitats and species related to forest, whereas the lower richness are closer to 0.

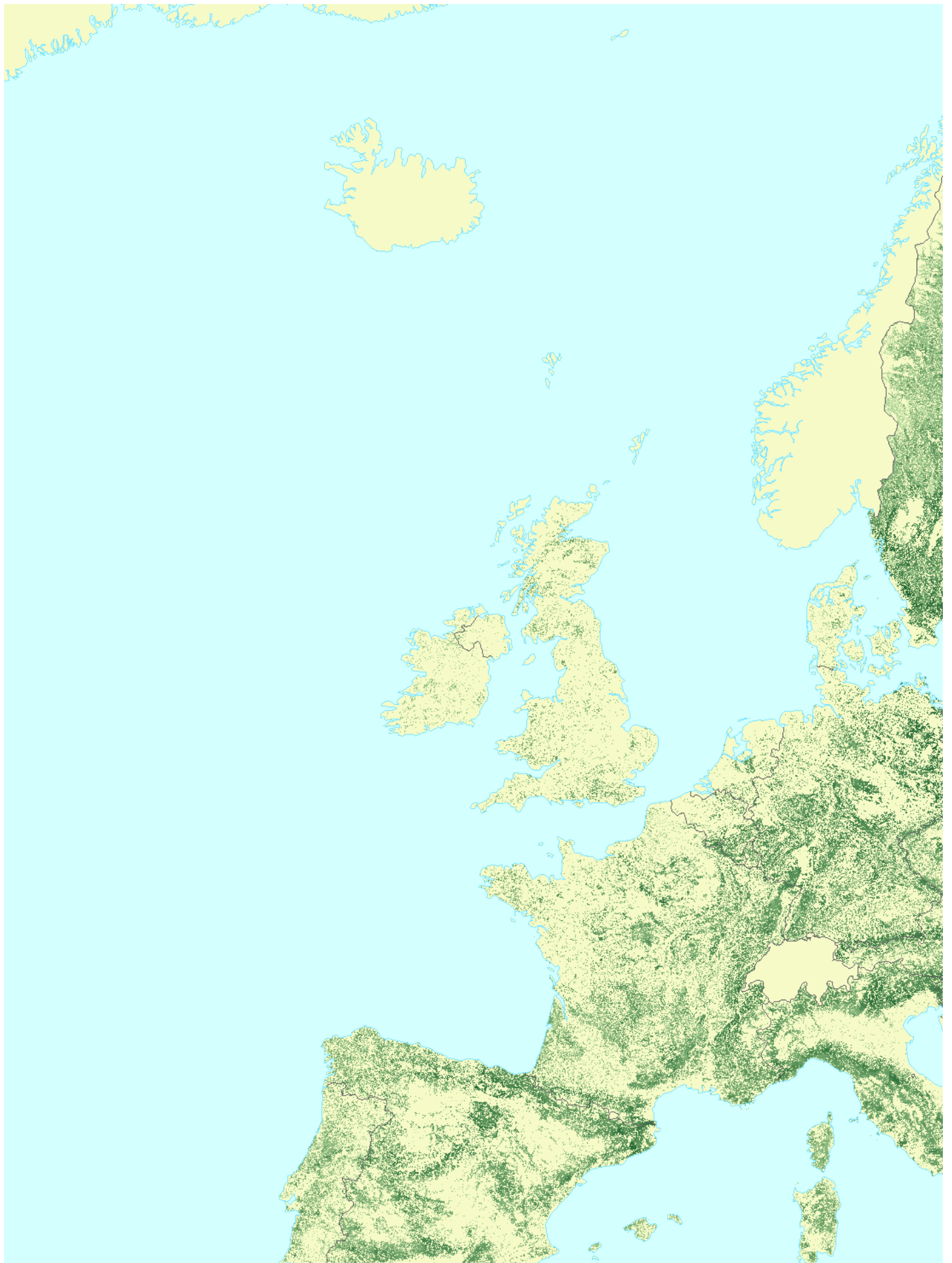


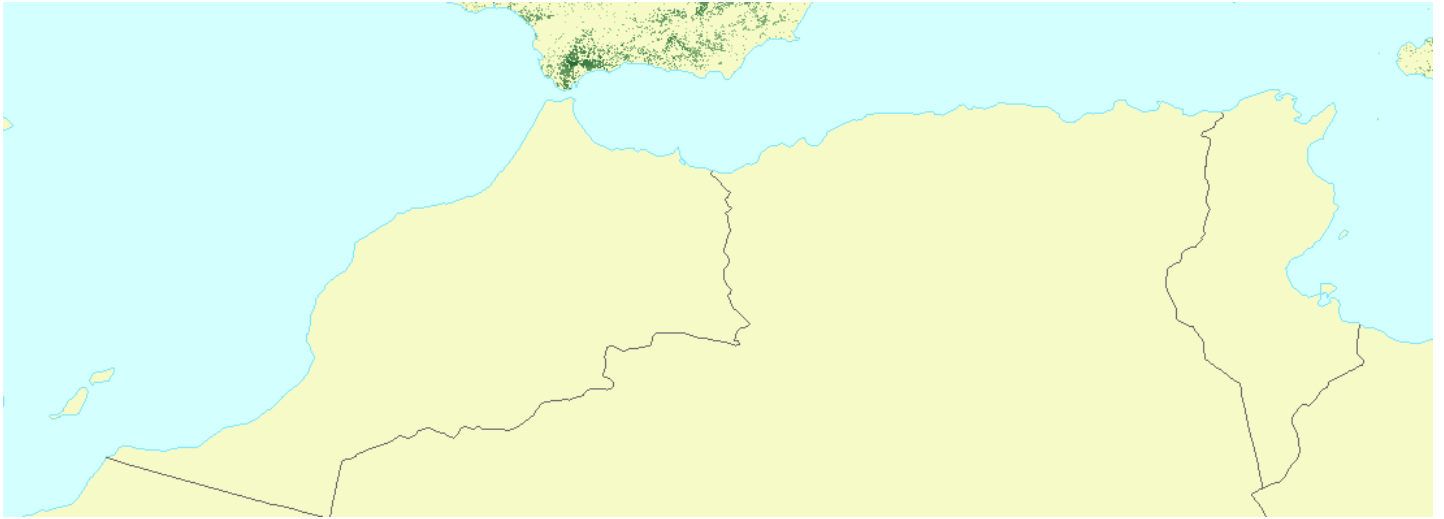
