Pursuant to Article 17 in “Regulation (EU) 2018/1999 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 December 2018 on the Governance of the Energy Union and Climate Action”, EU Member States must report to the Commission by 15 March 2023, and every two years thereafter, on the status of implementation of its integrated national energy and climate plan (NECP) by means of an integrated national energy and climate progress report (NECPR) covering all five dimensions of the Energy Union.

Pursuant to Article 18 in “Regulation (EU) 2018/1999 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 December 2018 on the Governance of the Energy Union and Climate Action”, EU Member States must report to the Commission by 15 March 2021, and every second year thereafter updated information on the national system for policies and measures and projections, the low-carbon development strategy, climate policies and measures and greenhouse gas projections.

Denmark’s previous ordinary updates pursuant to articles 17 and 18 were submitted to the Commission in 2023.

Denmark’s NECPR 2025 is reported as **Annex A** to the Memorandum in a separate EXCEL-file containing all the tables in Annex I-XXIV of the reporting format. Updated information on Denmark’s climate relevant policies and measures is contained in the table in Annex IX. In relation to Denmark’s long-term (/low-carbon development) strategy there are no changes since the 2023 update.

Updated information on the 2024 greenhouse gas projection (CSO24/KF24) was submitted to the Commission on 5 July and 29 August 2024. This is also the latest projection available by 15 March 2025. On request from the Commission, the 2024 projection is resubmitted in the 2025 reporting format. **Annex B** contains the required information for CSO24/KF24 in relation to reporting of projections – including a descriptive summary in English (Annex B1), the results (Annex B2⁵), projected indicators (Annex B3), projection parameters (Annex B4) and model facts (Annex B5).

The 2025 projection will not be available until June/July 2025 in its final version. A draft for public hearing will be published by the end of April 2025

In relation to the information on Denmark’s national system for policies and measures and projections reported in 2023, there are only a few updates. The updated description of Denmark’s national systems for policies and measures and projections pursuant to Article 36 is available in **Annex C**.

The above-mentioned information will be uploaded to ReportNET and ReportENER as appropriate.

⁵ As the latest year with projection estimates in CSO24/KF24 is 2040, and the requirement as of 2025 is to report projection estimates until 2055, the estimates for 2040 have been copied into the columns for 2045, 2050 and 2055.
